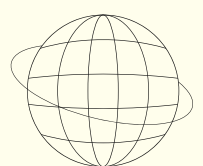
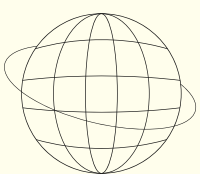

# 🌟 LOOKING AT YOU 🌟

## Training

There is loads of training that you can do to help with prey drive.

Recall is probably the most commonly advised piece of training but in this course we are not going to start there.

We are going to start with teaching your dog to look at you.

## Reasons

The reason we are starting there is that many high prey drive dogs struggle to take their focus off the environment around them at all when there might be prey around.

If they can't easily switch their focus between you and the environment then any training, including recalls is likely to fail.

So this course will concentrate on teaching looking at you as it will make all other training easier.

# THEORETICAL FRAMEWORK

## Train

There are 7 steps to teaching your dog to look at you.

## Practice

Practice the training in your house and garden including when you're going for a walk.

## Advanced Practice

Practice on your walks.

## Progress

Once the 7 steps are going well on walks, there is a final step to add in walking with your dog.
